A decision-driven monthly review format that anchors leadership on outcomes, learning, and focus.

HOW TO USE

A 8–10 slide monthly review that keeps leadership focused on outcomes, learning, and decisions—not activity. Keep it to 20 minutes.

Deck structure (copy/paste slide titles)

Slide	Title	What goes here (tight + decision-ready)
1	Executive summary	Top wins, top misses, key decisions needed (3 bullets each).
2	Outcomes dashboard	Primary business KPI(s), product KPI(s), and trust/guardrails vs last month.
3	OKR progress	Each objective with KR trend, confidence, and narrative (1 line per KR).
4	What we shipped (only if it changed something)	3–5 launches tied to outcomes; include before/after.
5	What we learned	Top experiments + insights; what changed in roadmap because of learning.
6	Focus & capacity	Where team spent time (themes), what we stopped, what we're not doing next.
7	Risks & dependencies	Top 3 risks with mitigation + explicit asks.
8	Decisions	Approve / reject / unblock items; include options + recommendation.
9	Deep dive	One narrative: a bet, a metric move, or a customer pain moment.
10	Appendix	Supporting data, experiment details, backlog cuts.
